- Faculty Inquiry Network
- Research Committees to consolidate data needs
- What do you want data output to look like?
- What other studies have been done? Lit review in house & out of site (Data Mart)

- Faculty & researchers not speaking the same language

Research Request

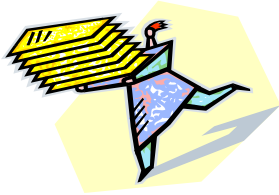


Current Strategies & Challenges in Data Coaching

- Research request form-nature of request prioritize
- Research agenda for recurring projects
- Link the request to existing institutional goals
- Informal process

Where can we improve the process?

- Opportunity to coach the requestor on what is already available
- Ask question/conversation to get enough information & help them to become part of the research process/design
- Build a relationship w/the requestor team
- Making a partnership with them

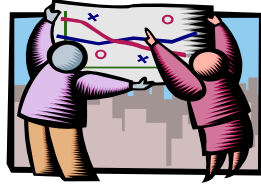

Current Strategies & Challenges in Data Coaching

- Meet to discuss the results in the report
- Training on utilizing existing reports
- Increase awareness of information available
- Discussions regarding the use of the results
- Discussions with report recipient regarding future avenues of investigation
- Packaging the information



Data Into Action

Current Strategies & Challenges in Data Coaching

- Involved in committees continually monitor use of data
 - a. Create ownership-Faculty ownership of Data get them involved from start
- Provide dashboards-data prompts
- End presentation with-now what are you going to do with the data
- Recommend actions to the group (preferably solicited from the end user)
- Link project data to something “bigger”-mission, program review, planning
- Report-but meet to discuss implications-discuss possible changes
- Communication between researchers and stakeholders
